JCCP-Aramco Symposium October 3 and 4, 2024 (CONRAD TOKYO)

JCCP-Aramco Symposium has been held under the theme of "Challenges & Opportunities Towards Low Carbon Society - role of technology and innovation –", focusing on the movement towards the social implementation, and encompassing the entire energy value chain from production to consumption of hydrogen, methanol, ammonia, and plastics recycling, etc.

Consisted of five sessions and a panel discussion, we held Session 1 entitled, "Policy and Demand Outlook", in which an overview concerning the symposium theme was presented by METI, the Institute of Energy Economics Japan, and KAPSARC. In Session 2 entitled, "Energy Innovation for a Sustainable Future", the oil wholesalers and Aramco RD revealed the latest result of their enterprise.
