The workshop for “ Exchange Project of good practice in refineries of KSA and Japan ”

Aramco which is the biggest oil company in the world and Japanese oil companies (Cosmo Oil, ENEOS and Idemitsu Kosan) held the workshop regarding the above title in Japan from December 2 to December 6. The purpose of this project is to introduce examples of refinery improvement and problem-solving initiatives, and to discuss them in a workshop to improve operations and develop young engineers on both sides.

The 4 members of Aramco from the head office and 3 major refineries came to Japan, they participated in the opening ceremony held in JCCP headquarter, etc. And then, they participated in the local workshop in Cosmo Oil Sakai Refinery and ENEOS Oita Refinery.

The theme in Sakai refinery session was refinery operation management and operators training , and the theme in Oita refinery session was Asset management and DX. Aramco and Japanese members introduced the examples of each theme and discussed them actively.

Through the workshop discussions, it was confirmed there are common issues for both Saudi Arabian and Japanese oil companies in refining, and further activities are expected in future.
