Most fossil fuels in Japan are imported from Gulf oil-producing countries, and there has been remarkable progress in promoting women's active participation in these countries upon the background of their national policies. The purpose of this forum is to discuss practical solutions to issues in promoting women's active participation in the oil and petrochemical industry through speeches and panel discussions with leaders and experts in Japan and the Gulf countries.

JCCP established the FCW Committee in 2015 in cooperation with the UAE's national oil company to support women's career development in oil companies in the UAE and Japan. Inviting participants from other Gulf countries, their discussed recommendations on women's active roles have been presented at the FCW forum and this is the 11th iteration\*.
