

Signing of an agreement with ADNOC Refining for “JCCP and ARRC joint Support for ADNOC Refining Refinery Operation (Phase III)”

On 16 June 2022, the Japan Cooperation Center Petroleum (JCCP) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with ADNOC Refining in the presence of Mr. Abdulla Ateya Al Messabi, CEO of ADNOC Refining, Mr. Eiji Hiraoka, Managing Director of JCCP, the Deputy Head of Mission at the Embassy of Japan in the United Arab Emirates and senior officials from Idemitsu Kosan.
